2016 BOATING INFORMATION SHEET

Boating will be permitted on **CONGERS LAKE** from **MAY 1** through **OCTOBER 31, 2016 WEATHER PERMITTING.**

HOURS - 8:00 AM – 7:00 PM, DAILY

HOW TO OBTAIN A BOATING PERMIT

STEP #1 Obtain your application form at the

**CONGERS COMMUNITY CENTER DURING BOAT INSPECTION TIMES

STEP #2 Fill out application form

STEP #3 Have your boat inspected at **Congers Lake Memorial Park**
Make sure to bring oars or paddles and life jackets
(Dates and times for boat inspections are listed below)


DATES: APRIL 1 - OCTOBER 21, 2016
HOURS: SATURDAYS: 11:00 AM - 1:00 PM
MONDAY - FRIDAY: 2:30 PM - 4:00 PM
TUESDAY EVENINGS: 7:00 PM - 8:15 PM

STEP #4 After boat has been inspected, go into the Recreation & Parks office to register your boat and prove residency. The Permit fee is **\$10.00**.
Senior Citizens free for first registered boat, \$10.00 fee for each additional boat.
Seniors must come into the Recreation & Parks office to register during registration hours listed below.

Proof of Residency is required (copy of Tax Bill/Current Utility Bill of primary residence)

Registration hours are as follows:
MONDAY - FRIDAY: 9:30 AM - 4:00 PM
TUESDAY & FRIDAY EVENINGS: 7:00 PM - 9:00 PM
SATURDAY MORNINGS: 10:00 AM - 12:00 NOON

STEP #5 After paying fee, affix your decal to your boat and "Safe Boating!"
(OVER)



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2016 PRIVATE BOAT PERMIT FOR CONGERS LAKE **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

Rules and Regulations as per Local Law #6 - Clarkstown Parks Board and Recreation Commission - to be observed at all times.

Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult when boating, except those in possession of power squadron certification.

The craft may be launched and taken out only in places designated.

The craft may not be stored on park property.

Swimming from any craft is not permitted.

THE CRAFT MUST BE A CAR TOP MOUNT TYPE. No boat trailers allowed.

Permits will be issued only to boats which are of rigid construction, open hulled and capable of safely seating occupants.

INFLATABLE CRAFTS ARE PERMITTED IF THEY ARE APPROVED BY THE NMMA (NATIONAL MARINE MANUFACTURERS ASSOCIATION.)

All boats are required to pass inspection at Congers Lake prior to issuing a boat permit.

Boating and use of Congers Lake is at your own risk.

No Boating by the Dam.

No gasoline motors permitted.

Electric motors are permitted.

Occupants must be seated when the boat is moving on the water.

STATE LAW - requires that there be one Coast Guard approved life preserver on board for **EACH** boat occupant. It is required that all children under 14 years of age must wear life preservers. We also strongly suggest **ALL** passengers wear preservers.

Animals are not permitted in any craft.

The Town of Clarkstown shall reserve the right to limit the number of boats on lake at any time.

MAXIMUM 50 boats on the lake at one time.

THE NUMBER DECAL ISSUED WITH THIS PERMIT MUST BE AFFIXED SECURELY TO THE BOAT ON THE STARBOARD (RIGHT) SIDE SO AS TO BE VISIBLE WHEN CRAFT IS AFLOAT. ONLY BOATS WITH OFFICIAL DECAL WILL BE ALLOWED ON CONGERS LAKE.

BOATING PERMITTED 8:00 AM TO DUSK EVERY DAY DURING THE BOATING SEASON.
THIS PERMIT MAY BE REVOKED FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH ANY OF THE ABOVE CONDITIONS.
