

TOWN OF CLARKSTOWN
LOCAL LAW NO. - 2011

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Clarkstown
as follows:

1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT: The Town of Clarkstown desires to eliminate the Office of the Receiver of Taxes and consolidate the duties of the Receiver of Taxes with the Office of the Assessor.
2. STATUTORY AUTHORITY: This local law is enacted under the authority of Municipal Home Rule Law §§ 10, 22 and 23. The Town hereby expressly states its intention that this local law shall supersede any provision of the Town Law of the State of New York to the contrary, including but not limited to Town Law §§ 20, 30 and 37.
3. PURPOSE: The purpose of this local law is to abolish the Office of the Receiver of Taxes in the Town of Clarkstown, New York.
4. ABOLITION; CONSOLIDATION OF POWERS AND DUTIES: The Office of the Receiver of Taxes in the Town of Clarkstown, New York is hereby abolished, effective January 1, 2014. The powers and duties of that Office shall be consolidated with the Office of the Assessor of the Town of Clarkstown, New York.
5. MANDATORY REFERENDUM: This local law shall be subject to mandatory referendum at the next regularly scheduled General Election on November 8, 2011.
6. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Local Law shall take effect upon the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors voting therein at such General Election on November 8, 2011, and the filing with the Office of the Secretary of State in accordance with the applicable provisions of law, on January 1, 2014.
