

SPECIAL TOWN BOARD MEETING

SEPTEMBER 19, 1938

Mr. Blauvelt explained that the special meeting was called in order that certain papers could be signed before the proposed project on the new Town Hall was submitted to the P.W.A. He explained that the reason for the haste in preparing the papers is due to the fact that September 30th, 1938 is the final date that projects may be submitted.

Dr. Gilchrest moved that a previous resolution authorizing the Supervisor, Roswell P. Blauvelt, to apply to the Federal Government for a P.W.A. grant of \$50,000. for a new Town Hall be rescinded.

Blauvelt, Supervisor, is hereby authorized and directed to furnish such information as the United States of America through the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works may reasonably request in connection with the application which is herein authorized to be filed.
