The minutes of the regular Town Board meeting held September 12th were approved as read.

The minutes of the two Special Town Board meetings held September 19th and 27th were approved as read.

Mr. Arthur Evans of Nanuet appeared before the Board and inquired what action had been taken by the Board in regard to the licensing of plumbers in the Town of Clarkstown.

Mr. Blauvelt explained that a change had been made in the original ordinance, and that the words "for hire" had been inserted in the original draft.

The Board informed Mr. Evans that they would hold the matter in abeyance until they could make a further study of the ordinance, and then definite action would be taken in the matter.

Mr. McGoveran appeared before the Board in regard to an addressograph machine for compiling the Tax Rolls and writing tax bills and receipts. The Board decided to lay this matter on the table until a later date.

Mr. Blauvelt read a letter to the Rockland Coaches, Inc. from various business men in Nanuet, protesting the action of the bus company in taking bus passengers directly to St. Agatha's Home without stopping in Nanuet.

The letter was ordered placed on file.

Dr. Gilchrest moved that Mr. Jackomin of Upper Nyack be recommended for appointment as a Police Officer, providing his qualifications are satisfactory.
