

TOWN BOARD MEETING AND PUBLIC HEARING

NOVEMBER 14, 1938

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Blauvelt.

Mr. Blauvelt read a petition from taxpayers in the Congers Lighting District requesting the installation of a street light.

Dr. Gilchrest moved that a street light be installed in the Congers Lighting District on Ohio Avenue on New York Telephone Company pole #12, the cost of the same to be a charge against the Congers Lighting District.

Mr. Blauvelt read a letter from the Public Service Commission in regard to the addition of another grade crossing on Route 59 at Nanuet.

Mr. Baker moved the Supervisor write the Public Service Commission and acknowledge receipt of the letter.

Mr. Blauvelt read a petition signed by residents on Dustman's Lane, Bardonia, requesting gas service to their homes.

Mr. Baker moved that the matter be referred to the Rockland Gas Company for their further attention.

Mr. Blauvelt read a letter from the Civic Board of Clarkstown, opposing the licensing of plumbers and requesting that another public hearing be held on the matter since there has been a change made in the original ordinance, and they further requested that the meeting be held in the evening.

The letter of the Civic Board of Clarkstown was ordered filed.

The Board decided to defer the matter of licensing plumbers until a future meeting when all members of the Town Board are present.

The Board discussed the matter of dividing the Nanuet Election District and making two districts instead of one, inasmuch as this particular district has such a large number of voters that it is almost impossible to vote them within the time allotted.

Dr. Gilchrest moved that the Town Board act as a committee to investigate and make recommendations regarding the division of the Nanuet Election District.

Mr. Blauvelt read a letter from the Select Service, Inc. in regard to dismantling and wrecking.

It was ordered filed.

Mr. Blauvelt read a letter from Henry Krell requesting to be reinstated on the Clarkstown Police Force.

Dr. Gilchrest moved that the letter be laid on the table until such time as Mr. Liebert, Chief of Police, may be consulted.

Mr. Blauvelt read a letter from the Security Title And Guaranty Company inquiring if the Town contemplated purchasing any property, and if so, urging the insuring of the title.

The letter was ordered placed on file.

Mr. Baker moved that Interstate Commerce Commission of Washington, D.C. be notified that the Town Board opposes the abandonment of the New City Branch of the N. J. & N. Y. R. R. Company running between New City and Nanuet, a distance of approximately 4.6 miles.

Mr. William Blanche and Mr. Fred Dick were the only two taxpayers who appeared at the Public Hearing in reference to the proposed 1939 budget. They both praised the police department and requested that the amount set up in the budget be left as set up, and that if the

Chief of Police saw fit to ask for an increase, it be granted to him. Mr. Dick also praised the work of the highway department and stated that he felt the amount requested for that department was not excessive.
