

TOWN BOARD MEETING

DECMEBER 15,1938

Mr. Blauvelt called the meeting to order.

A public hearing having been held on a proposed ordinance to license, etc. plumbers in the Town of Clarkstown on the 12th day of September, 1938, at 2:00 o'clock P. M. (Daylight Saving Time), in the office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Clarkstown, at which hearing a number of people for and against the adoption of the proposed ordinance, as published, were heard, and the Town Board having duly taken the matter under consideration and due deliberation having been had thereon, it is, on motion of Councilman Norman R. Baker, seconded by Councilman B. Otto Jacobsen

RESOLVED, that the said ordinance, as originally prepared and published, be and the same hereby is rejected, and it is

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following proposed ordinance licensing plumbers in the Town of Clarkstown, viz:

PROPOSED ORDINANCE LICENSING PLUMBERS
IN THE TOWN OF CLARKSTOWN

ARTICLE I

The Town Board of the Town of Clarkstown, County of Rockland and State of New York, hereby ordains, enacts and publishes as follows:

Section 1. The doing of any plumbing or plumbing work for hire in the Town of Clarkstown by any person, firm or corporation, is hereby prohibited, except by or through persons, firms or corporations, holding a license issued by the Town Board of the Town of Clarkstown.

Section 2. All applicants for such libense must appear in person before the Town Board and submit such proof as will enable the Town Board to determine the financial responsibility of the applicants to receive such license.

Section 3. A license fee of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars per annum and a renewal fee of Five (\$5.00) Dollars per annum is hereby imposed, which must be payable in advance. All licenses shall expire on December

31st of each year. Where the license is issued subsequent to January 1st of any year, the license fee will be prorated in accordance with the length of time that the license has to run.

ARTICLE II

Penalty

Section 1. All persons violating this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than Five (\$5.00) Dollars nor more than Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars for each day that such violation exists. The doing of plumbing or plumbing work on each day shall constitute a separate violation of this ordinance.

Section 2. The Town Board hereby also ordains that a violation of this ordinance shall constitute disorderly conduct and that any person violating the same shall be deemed a disorderly person. The Town Board also may enforce obedience to this ordinance and restrain the violation thereof by injunction.

ARTICLE III

In Effect

Section 1. This ordinance shall take effect immediately.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk be and she hereby is directed to give notice of a public hearing on said ordinance to be held at the office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Clarkstown in New City, New York, on the 28th day of December, 1938, at 2:00 o'clock in the afternoon of that day, and it is

FURTHER RESOLVED, that said notice be given by publishing the same in the "Journal-News", a daily newspaper circulating in the Town of Clarkstown, on the 17th day of December, 1938, which is at least ten days prior to the date specified for said hearing. Such notice shall specify the time when and the place where such public hearing will be held and will contain a copy of the said proposed ordinance.

On motion of Councilman Norman R. Baker, seconded by Councilman B. Otto Jacobsen, the foregoing resolutions were adopted by the following vote:
