

TOWN BOARD MEETING

October 9th, 1939

Mr. Blauvelt called the meeting to order.

Mrs. Buchenau read the minutes of the regular meeting held September 11th and Special Meetings held September 23rd and October 2nd, 1939.

Fisher, Chairman of the Rockland County Democratic Committee, recommending the appointment of Alfred Biltz for the position of Election inspector in the West Nyack Election District to fill the vacancy caused by the transfer of Mr. Elmer Brown to the Bardonia election district.

Mr. Eberling moved that a street light be installed on Palisade Avenue (also known as Grace Street) between Middletown Road and Highview Avenue where the same intersects Park Place in Nanuet, in accordance with petition filed by residents and taxpayers of Nanuet.

Dr. Gilchrest requested that Mr. Blauvelt address a letter to the Civic Board of Congers and ask them how many street signs they would like and also where they would like the signs placed.

Mr. McGill spoke to the Board relative to a street light in the Nanuet Lighting Dist. which had been taken out and never replaced.

Mr. Eberling was appointed as a committee to see why the light was taken out of the district.

Supt. of Highways, Emil Klein, spoke to the Board regarding Van Nostrand Place in Nanuet. He said that he had had a request for a permit to open the street for water mains, and that he had granted one, since it was his understanding that the road is a Town road. Later he had been advised that Mr. McGill had refused to allow the street to be opened claiming that it is a private road, although the Town has maintained said road for a number of years.

Mr. McGill told the Board that the road was a private one, as he had never deeded it to the Town. He indicated that he was willing the water mains should be put in, but insisted that a 6 inch pipe be laid, so that the road would not have to be torn up in future.

Mr. Fred Braun appeared before the Board and pointed out that all he wanted was the right to put a water line into his home, since he is now without water, and some assurance that the road would be taken over by the Town, if it is not already a Town road. He said that Mr. McGill had called the police and stopped him from putting in the water pipe, as he claims the road is a private one, and that it was never deeded to the Town.

The matter was referred to Mr. Lexow, attorney, for his further attention and advice.

Mr. Ewell appeared before the Board in regard to a road in Piping Rock, West Nyack, known as Park Lane. He offered to deed this property to the Town, but desires to reserve the right to withhold a five foot strip.

The Board was unanimous in their opinion that they would not be willing to accept a dead end road, since by doing so they would be setting a precedent, as no dead end roads have ever been taken over by the Town.

Dr. Gilchrest moved that the 1% fee on School Taxes be omitted for the first thirty days of collection.
