

PUBLIC HEARING

On the proposed changes in the Zoning Ordinance
of the Town of Clarkstown

April 2nd, 1941

Mr. Blauvelt opened the Hearing, and advised those present that the Hearing had been called for the purpose of considering two applications for changes in the Zoning Ordinance. One is the application of Mrs. Eva Baar to change her property on Route 59 from Residence B to Business B, and the other is the application of Garrett Miller to change his property on Route 59 from Residence A to Business B. Mr. Blauvelt then requested those present who wished to speak either for or against the proposed changes to come forward, give their names and express their views.

There was no one present who spoke regarding the change of Eva Baar.

There were four persons who spoke in favor of changing the Garrett Miller property, and there were five persons who spoke against such a change.

After all those present had been given the opportunity to express their views, on motion of Mr. Goebel, seconded by Mr. Eberling and carried, the hearing was declared closed.
