

SPECIAL TOWN BOARD MEETING

April 14th, 1943

Mr. Blauvelt called the meeting to order.

Mr. Blauvelt told the Board he had received letters from the Association of Towns and also from the Department of Audit and Control regarding the amendment to the Tax Law, effective February 1st, 1943. He said that under this amendment taxes may be paid on or before January 31st without interest. However, on all taxes remaining unpaid after January 31st, 1% is added for the first month and the percentage increased for each month thereafter. He said that the law permits Town Boards to adopt a resolution before April 15th recommending that taxes be collected at the rate of penalties provided before the enactment of the new law. Mr. Blauvelt further pointed out that the Association of Towns recommends collecting taxes for 1943 as outlined in the Tax Notices, and he said none of the other towns in the county plan on changing the method of collection for this year.

The Board members then discussed the resolution adopted at the April 7th meeting, whereby the changes to the Tax Law were approved and adopted.

Dr. Gilchrest moved that the following resolution adopted at a meeting of the Town Board on April 7th, 1943 be rescinded.

RESOLVED, that the amendment to the Tax Law effective February 1st, 1943, changing the schedule of fees, penalties and interest be approved and that the Town adopt the new schedule of fees, penalties and interest included in the Albee bill.
