

SPECIAL TOWN BOARD MEETING

October 1st, 1943

Mr. Blauvelt called the meeting to order, and explained to the Board that pursuant to the Town Law, the Board must receive the estimates of the various departments of the Town for the 1944 Budget.

Mr. Blauvelt then presented the estimated budgets for each department of the Town for the 1944 Budget, and the Town Board reviewed each one very carefully.

Mr. Dickenman again brought up the matter of Smith St. in Rockland Lake and the request that the road be repaired out of highway taxes, since it is not a town highway.

The Board then took up the matter with Emil Klein, Supt. of Highways, who was present at the meeting, and Mr. Klein advised the Board that Mr. Manganeli had told the Board of Appeals that he had the politicians under his finger and could get them to do anything he wanted. He said that he was not even acquainted with Mr. Manganeli. Mr. Klein further told the Board that if they would instruct him to do this work, he would do so but that he would not do the work of his own accord unless Mr. Manganeli made an apology to the Board.

There was no further action taken by the Board on this matter.

Dr. Gilchrest reported that about \$200.00 would cover the entire cost of a history of Clarkstown's part in this war.

Dr. Gilchrest moved the meeting be adjourned.
