

SPECIAL TOWN BOARD MEETING

September 29th, 1944

Mr. Blauvelt called the meeting to order.

Chief Liebert told the Board that he has again been requested for police protection at West Nyack, and that he had advised that if a man could be found to do this work, there was sufficient money in his budget to pay the cost. He also brought to the attention of the Board a bad traffic condition at the Four Corners in West Nyack. He recommended that Mr. Allison, Co. Engineer, be requested to put up suitable "No Parking" signs for a distance of approximately 200 feet along the east side of Strawtown Road. Parking has been on both sides of the highway, and this has caused a dangerous hazard.

Mr. Blauvelt told the Chief that he would communicate with Mr. Allison regarding the "No Parking" signs.

Mr. Blauvelt told the Board that Mr. Elliott, Building Inspector, had spoken to him regarding the continuance of his telephone, which was paid for by the Town under Bardonia Defense Center. The telephone was also used in his work as Building Inspector. Since the telephone service for defense work is being discontinued, he would like to have the telephone service paid by the Town, since it will be used in connection with his work as Building Inspector.

The Board then reviewed all the budget estimates from the various departments of the Town.

Mr. Dickenman moved the meeting be adjourned.
