Mr. Dillon called the meeting to order.

Mr. Louis Heydeman of Nanuet, came before the Board as spokesman for the Nanuet Civic Association. Mr. Heydeman stated that the Civic Assn. had adopted a resolution requesting the Town Board to increase the Police Dept. by three (3) men, and also to grant the Dept. as a whole a ten percent (10%) increase in pay.

Mr. Dillon informed Mr. Heydeman that the Board would seriously consider the Nanuet Civic Assn's. request.

The Town Clerk presented the 1951 budget estimates of the various Town departments of the Town to the Board.

The Town Board then reviewed each estimate and prepared the Preliminary Budget for 1951.

Mr. Eberling then presented to the Board deeds for two roads to be taken over by the Town. These roads were Fenner Lane and Caravella Lane, both in Nanuet.

Superintendent of Highways, Emil Klein, came before the Board and said that both Fenner Lane and Caravella Lane met specifications and could be taken over.

The deeds were referred to the Town Attorney to check before any official action was taken by the Town Board.

There being no further business to come before the Board, Mr. Schmersahl moved adjournment.

Seconded by Mr. Fibble.
