Mr. Dillon called the meeting to order, explaining that it has been called to prove the petition of the Village of Spring Valley for the annexation of a portion of the Town of Clarkstown.

Town Attorney Edward G. Roepe explained to the residents present that the Village had presented the petition to the Town Board and their sole duty is to determine if the petition is legal and proper. When the petition has been approved by the Town Board it is returned to the Village and at that time the Village Board will hold a public hearing to hear all objections. He said that the Town Board has no jurisdiction over the annexation.


Robert Granik, Attorney for the Village, came before the Board and testified that the petition had been signed by 51% of the property owners of the area.
