Mr. Dillon called the hearing to order, explaining that it had been called to consider the application of K. Harry Zeh for permission to operate a Bus line in the Town of Clarkstown.

Mr. Zeh, owner of the Bus. Co. came before the Board and stated that he had applied to the Public Service Comm. for a franchise, and it was necessary for the Town Board to adopt a resolution granting permission to establish the route before the franchise could be obtained.

Mr. Dillon asked if there was anyone present in opposition to the petition.

No one appeared before the Board in opposition.

Mr. Burleigh moved the following resolution:

RESOLVED, that the application of K. Harry Zeh for permission to operate a bus line through the Town of Clarkstown along the following roads be granted, subject to his obtaining a Certificate of authority from the Public Service Commission of the State of NewYork:

West on West Clarkstown Road from Burda Ave., North on West Clarkstown Road to NewHempstead Road, West on New Hempstead Road to the Town Line, and that portion of Eckerson Road within the Town of Clarkstown.

There being no further business, the hearing was adjourned.

Mr. Dillon called the meeting to order, explaining that it has been called to receive the bids for Bonds for machinery for the Town Dump.

Mr. Dillon presented the following bids:

Peoples Bank of Haverstraw	\$20,031.25	1.80%
Roosevelt & Cross, NewYork	20,011.00	4.5%
Nanuet National Bank	20,020.00	1.70%
Pearl River 1st National	20,000.00	2.0%

Mr. Roepe informed the Board that in accordance with the provisions of the Finance Law, the acceptance of the bids is based on the rate of interest offered and not on the amount of the premium.

Mr. Welchman moved the following resolution.

AWARDING \$20,000 serial bonds of 1954, of the Town of Clarkstown to Nanuet National Bank being the successful bidder.

WHEREAS, pursuant to resolution of the Town Board dated April 22nd, 1954, \$20,000 in principal amount of Town of Clarkstown bonds were authorized to be sold at public sale, and

WHEREAS, the said notice of sale was duly advertised pursuant to statute and the rule or order of the Comptroller of the State of New York, and

WHEREAS, Nanuet National Bank offered the lowest rate of interest for said bonds,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that said bid of Nanuet National Bank be and the same is hereby accepted and that said bond issue of \$20,000 be and the same is hereby awarded to Nanuet National bank pursuant to the terms of its bid.

Seconded by Mr. Schmersahl.

The Town Clerk was instructed to return the deposits of the unsuccessful bidders and notify them accordingly.
