Mr. Dillon called the meeting to order.

Mr. Dillon presented a notice of public hearing from the Public Service Comm. The Notice stated that a hearing would be held on the petition of the West Shore Railroad to discontinue the services of the Gate Attendant at the Lake Road crossing at Congers.

Mr. Fibble moved the following resolution:

RESOLVED, that the Town Board of Clarkstown does hereby oppose the petition of the West Shore Railroad to remove the Gate Attendant at the Lake Road crossing at Congers, and,

FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Public Service Comm. with the request that the petition be denied.

Seconded by Mr. Schmersahl.

Carried.

Mr. Dillon also informed the Board that the Rockland Bus Line had discontinued local Routes 2 and 7 to West Nyack Railroad Station and many complaints had been received.

Mr. Burleigh moved the following resolution:

WHEREAS, Rockland Bus Lines have discontinued Local Routes 2 and 7 at West Nyack, New York, and,

WHEREAS, no advance notice of the discontinuance of these routes was given to the general public,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of Clarkstown vigorously oppose such action by the Rockland Bus. Co. and requests that service be restored at the earliest possible date.

The Town Clerk was instructed to send copies of the resolution to the Bus Company and the Interstate Commerce Comm.

Mr. Burleigh moved the following resolution:

RESOLVED, that the resolution of the Town Board adopted on Jan. 7, 1955, setting time of Town Board meetings be amended as follows:

1st meeting to be held on 2nd Friday at 7:30 P.M.
 2nd meeting to be held on 4th Thursday at 7:30 P.M.

Seconded by Mr. Welchman.
