Mr. Dillon called the meeting to order.

Mr. Dillon presented a new petition for Nelson Place. He explained that the bid for the construction of this street had exceeded the amount of the original petition and it was necessary to start the entire procedure over again.

Mr. Welchman moved the following order:

WHEREAS, a written petition, dated October 24th, 1955, was on the 1st day of November, 1955, duly filed with this board pursuant to Section 200 of the Town Law of the State of New York for the improvement of the highway in said Town known as Nelson Place, by paving the entire length thereof in accordance with the Town specifications as contained in Resolution of the Town Board of May 13, 1951, and whereas it duly appears that such petition has been duly signed by the owners of real estate owning at least one-half of the entire frontage or bounds on both sides of said Nelson Place, and whereas it duly appears that such petition was also duly signed by resident owners owning not less than one-half of the frontage owned by resident owners residing along said Nelson Place; and whereas such petition was duly acknowledged or proved by all the signers thereof in the same manner as a deed to be recorded; and whereas the maximum amount proposed to be expended for the improvement of said highway as stated in the petition is the sum of \$5,200.00; it is, pursuant to the provisions of said Section 200 of the Town Law of the State of New York, hereby

ORDERED that the Town Board of the Town of Clarkstown, Rockland County, New York, shall meet at the Town Clerk's office at Main Street, New City, in the said Town of Clarkstown on the 9th day of December, 1955, at 9:00 o'clock in the evening of that day, Eastern Standard Time, for the purpose of considering the said petition and hearing all persons interested in the subject thereof concerning the same; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that the Town Clerk of the Town of Clarkstown cause duly certified copies of this order to be published and posted in the manner required by Section 200 of the Town Law.

Seconded by Mr. Fibble.

On roll call, the vote of the Board was as follows:

Mr. Burleigh moved the following resolution:

RESOLVED, that Adolph Gazan of New City be appointed Dog Enumerator for the Town of Clarkstown for 1956.
