Supervisor Dillon opened the hearing.

The Clerk read notice of hearing to consider petition of Carworth Farms, Inc. and others for the extension of the New City-West Nyack Water Supply District.

E. Alfred Festa, Esq. appeared representing the petitioner. For the record it was brought out that Assessor's affidavit was attached to petition, showing that over 50% of owners of taxable real property had signed the petition and over 50% of the assessed valuation of all taxable real property assessed to resident property owners on the last completed assessment roll was included.

Mr. John W. Cumming of Congers Road, New City, was introduced by Attorney Festa, who stated he wished to testify.

After being sworn by Mr. Dillon, when questioned by Attorney Festa, Mr. Cumming testified as follows:

Q: Mr. Cumming, you are an officer of Carworth Farms, Inc.?

A: I am.

Q: What is your capacity?

A: Vice-President.

Q: Carworth Farms, Inc. is one of the property owners signing this petition?

A: That is right.

Q: Will you tell the Board here that the property and all property owners are within the proposed district?

A: They are.

Q: Are the property and property owners benefited included within the limits of the proposed district?

A: Yes.

Q: Is the granting of this relief sought herein for the public interest of all concerned?

A: Yes. It is.

Q: What are your reasons for the public interest?

A: For the protection of property and lives.

Upon being questioned by Town Attorney Edward G. Roepe, Mr. Cumming answered as follows:

Q: In your opinion is there anybody whose property is not included in this proposed extension who will be benefited by the creating of the extension of this Water District?

A: No.

Supervisor Dillon then inquired whether anyone else was interested and wished to testify.

No one appeared and Mr. Jeffrey made a motion that the hearing be closed. Seconded by Mr. Schmersahl.
