Jacob Pesner, Esq., Village Attorney appeared on behalf of the Village of Spring Valley.

Supervisor Coyle opened the hearing.

The reading of the notice of hearing was dispensed with due to the fact that all present were familiar with the petition for the Annexation to the Village of Spring Valley, territory adjoining said village in the Town of Clarkstown.

David Coral, Esq., Attorney for the petitioners, Herbert A. Burns, Robert Atkins and Rebecca Atkins, informed the Board that the area in the proposed annexation amounted to 8.479 acres. He also stated that the petition was signed by 100% of the Taxable owners and 66% of the resident owners.

Mr. Coral filed with the clerk the petition which was marked "Exhibit B" and the affidavit of posting which was marked "Exhibit B".

Supervisor Coyle asked if anyone was present who objected, pursuant to Section 348 of the Village Law.

There were no objections.

The hearing was held open a while longer, and Miss Catherine A. Buckeley of 306 Lawrence Street, Spring Valley appeared before the Board and asked the boundaries of the proposed annexation.

After Miss Buckley and Mrs. Coughlin were assured that their properties were not within the proposed annexation, they had no objections.

On motion of Mr. Renken, seconded by Mr. Welchman, the hearing was declared closed.
