Supervisor Coyle called the meeting to order, stating it had been scheduled primarily to consider and adopt the Preliminary Budget for the year 1960, but that there were a few other matters that needed attention.

The Supervisor read a letter dated Oct. 2, 1959 from Everett Crosby, Chairman of the Clarkstown Democratic Committee recommending replacements as Democratic Inspectors of Election.

Mr. Danko moved the following resolution:

RESOLVED, that the following persons be appointed Democratic Inspectors of Election in the following Election Districts:

Election District #3 -- Mrs. Mary Goodyear in place of Evelyn Moyer

Election District #13 -- Beatrice Newton in place of Marie Morch

Election District #19 -- Nancy Talaska in place of James Kelly

Election District #21 -- Marion Henn in place of Evelyn Rudman

Seconded by Mr. Renken.

On roll call, the vote was as follows:

Monthly report of the Dog Warden for the month of September was submitted to the Board and placed on file.

The Supervisor told the Board that Mr. Welchman was ill but had 'phoned and stated if he were needed at the meeting he would be present. Mr. Coyle advised him that unless something unforeseen arose, it would not be necessary.

Supervisor Coyle called attention to a newspaper item in the Journal-News quoting a statement made by Paul Mundt about legislation with respect to State-Owned Lands Assessments. He then read to the Board excerpts from the minutes of the Town Board meetings on Feb. 6th and 24th, 1959 with reference thereto. The Town Attorney then reviewed for the benefit of the Board members, the details of a meeting in Albany with Dr. Whitaker and with Mr. Bergren.

Supervisor Coyle read a letter dated Oct. 8, 1959 from Albert Wein of the P.T.A. Safety Council, asking passage of a \$20,000.00 appropriation for sidewalks in the 1960 budget.

The Preliminary Budget for 1960 was then discussed in detail.

Mr. Renken moved the following resolution:

RESOLVED, that this Town Board does hereby prepare and approve as the Preliminary Budget for this Town for the Fiscal year beginning on the 1st day of January, 1960, the itemized statement of estimated revenues and expenditures hereto itemized and made a part of this resolution, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that such Preliminary Budget shall be filed in the office of the Town Clerk where it shall be available for inspection by any interested person at all reasonable hours; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Board shall meet at 8:00 o'clock P. M. on the 4th day of November, 1959, for the purpose of holding a public hearing on such Preliminary Budget, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk give notice of such public hearing in the manner provided in Section 113 of the Town Law, and that such notice be published and posted in substantially the following form;

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Annual Preliminary Budget of the Town of Clarkstown for the year 1960 has been completed and filed in the office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Clarkstown; that the Town Board of said Town will at a meeting thereof to be held at the Town Clerk's Office, 16 South Main Street, New City, in the Town of Clarkstown, County of Rockland, New York, on the 4th day of November, 1959, at 8:00 o'clock P. M. hold a hearing thereupon and review said budget, and any person may be heard in favor of or against the budget, as compiled, or for or against any item or items therein contained.
