Supervisor Coyle called the meeting to order.

On motion made by Mr. Renken, seconded by Mr. Danko and unanimously carried, the Board went into executive session.

On motion made by Mr. Jeffrey, seconded by Mr. Danko and unanimously carried, the Board returned to the meeting.

Mr. Renken moved the following resolution:

WHEREAS, Leonard Schwall, Assessor of the Town of Clarkstown, has brought certain charges of misconduct and incompetency against Frank Foley, Assistant Assessor of the Town of Clarkstown, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has reviewed these charges with Leonard Schwall, Assessor, and

WHEREAS, Section 75 of the Civil Service Law of the State of New York requests service of a written notice of the proposed action of the Town Board, a written copy of the charges and eight (8) days to answer the charges in writing.

NOW THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, That Frank Foley, Assistant Assessor, be served with written notice, that removal or other disciplinary action may be taken by the Town Board, and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Town Attorney prepare formal written charges as prescribed by Section 75 of the Civil Service Law, and be it further

RESOLVED, that a written copy of the charges be sent to Frank Foley, Assistant Assessor and that he be allowed eight (8) days for answering the same in writing; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Board hold a hearing upon such charges on November 30, 1959, at 8:00 P. M. Eastern Standard time, at the office of the Supervisor, 40 Maple Avenue, New City, New York.

Supervisor Coyle stated for the record that in a discussion with Mr. Frank Foley at an informal meeting on November 10th, 1959 the Board had been informed by him that he had two weeks vacation coming to him for 1959 or the year 1957 and Mr. Foley was directed to take his vacation immediately. The Supervisor added that Mr. Foley's vacation would expire on November 24th, 1959.

Mr. Renken moved the following resolution:

RESOLVED, that Frank Foley, Assistant Assessor, be suspended, with pay, from his duties in the Assessor's office from November 25th, 1959 until a determination of the charges brought against him by Leonard Schwall, Assessor, is made, such suspension not to exceed a period of thirty days.

Seconded by Mr. Welchman.

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On roll call, the vote was as follows:
