(466) Councilman Holbrook offered the following resolution:

WHEREAS, The Town of Clarkstown after thorough consideration of the various aspects of the problem and study of available data has hereby determined that the construction of certain public works, generally described as Lateral Sewers in Sewer Districts No. 16 and 17 is desirable and in the public interest and to that end it is necessary that action preliminary to the construction of said works be taken immediately; and

WHEREAS, under the terms of Public Law 560, 83rd Congress, as amended, the United States has authorized the making of advances to public bodies to aid in financing the cost of engineering and architectural surveys, designs, plans, working drawings, specifications or other preliminary to and in preparation for the construction of public works; and

WHEREAS, the applicant has examined and duly considered such act and the applicant considers it to be in the public interest and to its benefit to file an application under said act and to authorize other action in connection therewith;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY The Town Board the governing body of said applicant, as follows:

1. That the construction of said public works is essential to and is to the best interests of the applicant, and to the end that such public works may be provided as promptly as practicable it is desirable that action preliminary to the construction thereof be undertaken immediately;

2. That the Supervisor be hereby authorized to file in behalf of the applicant an application (in form required by the United States and in conformity with said act) for an advance to be made by the United States to the applicant to aid in defraying the cost of plan preparation for the above described public works, which shall consist generally of Final Engineering and Contract Documents for Lateral Sewers in Sewer Districts No. 16 and 17.

3. That if such advance be made, the applicant shall provide or make necessary arrangements to provide such funds, in addition to the advance, as may be required to defray the cost of the plan preparation of such public works;

4. The said Supervisor is hereby authorized to furnish such information and take such action as may be necessary to enable the applicant to qualify for the advance;

5. That the officer designated in the preceding paragraph is hereby designated as the authorized representative of the applicant for the purpose of furnishing to the United States such information, data, and documents pertaining to the application for an advance as may be required; and otherwise to act as the authorized representative of the applicant in connection with this application.

6. That certified copies of this resolution be included as part of the application for an advance to be submitted to the United States.

Mr. Paul Bavaro appeared before Board re Tucker Avenue:
(1) Pole obstructing traffic; and (2) Safety between Tucker Ave. and New Route 304 for children. (Fence or Iron Railing). Supervisor mentioned that since we have not taken over road as yet, nothing can be done at present. Highway Superintendent was requested to give his recommendation.

Re request for meeting with State Traffic Commission in connection with Demarest Mill Rd and Route 304, since no reply received from the Commission as yet, Town Clerk was instructed by Councilman Frohling to follow through and communicate with the Commission again to request said meeting.

On resolution offered by Councilman Frohling, seconded by Councilman Danko and unanimously adopted, Town Board Meeting was adjourned until Monday, June 21st, 1965.
