Supervisor Mundt called Town Board meeting to order at 2:00 P.M.

Supervisor Mundt read statement indicating consolidation of auditing and purchasing for the year 1967 which will be made official at the Organizational Meeting to be held on January 4th, 1967 to take effect no later than January 15th, 1967

(999) Councilman Holbrook offered the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the Town of Clarkstown has provided for the construction of a highway garage on the Gray property in Nanuet, New York, and

WHEREAS, a bond anticipation note has been authorized to pay the cost of construction of said highway garage and acquisition of property therefor, and

WHEREAS, certain costs of acquisition of property for said garage have become due and payable;

NOW THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, that the sum of \$1,817.50 shall be transferred from CURRENT SURPLUS GENERAL to Town Building Fund (Highway Garage Site) Account in order to pay said costs, which transfer from surplus shall be reimbursed from the proceeds of the sale of said bond anticipation note, pursuant to Sec. 165 of the Local Finance Law, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that suitable records shall be kept for the temporary diversion of such funds.



WHEREAS, Strawberry Hill Lane special improvement was a duly authorized special road improvement for the Town of Clarkstown, and

WHEREAS, upon completion of the work, it was deemed that a portion of this work was not satisfactory and that full payment should be withheld pending completion of the work alleged not to have been performed according to contract specifications, and

WHEREAS, the Town Engineer of the Town of Clarkstown, by letter dated December 9, 1966, has recommended that the work be accepted and that a maintenance bond in the amount of \$1,060.00 be held for a period of one year;

NOW THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, that the Supervisor is authorized to make payment of invoices outstanding on Strawberry Hill Lane special road improvement, withholding the amount of \$1,060.00 as a cash bond until such time as a substitute maintenance bond is furnished in that amount for a period of one year, whichever sooner occurs and upon receipt of satisfactory evidence of payment to subcontractors and suppliers.

Seconded by Councilman Damiani.

All voted Aye.

On resolution offered by Councilman Holbrook, seconded by Councilman Damiani and unanimously adopted, Town Board meeting was adjourned until January 4th, 1967/at which time Organizational Meeting for the year 1967 8:00 P.M.) will be held.
