Supervisor Mundt called Town Board Meeting to order at 8:00 P.M.

(155) Councilman Damiani offered following resolution:

RESOLVED that minutes of one (1) public hearing held on 2/13/67 and minutes of regular Town Board meeting held on 2/15/67 are hereby approved and accepted as submitted by the Town Clerk.

(156) Councilman Frohling offered the following resolution:

WHEREAS, a vacancy has occurred in the office of Town Historian for the Town of Clarkstown, due to the resignation of Louise A. Linder, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Supervisor be authorized to execute the necessary Civil Service form for the Temporary appointment until December 31, 1967 of ANNETTE LUNDGREN of 22 Judith Street, Nanuet, New York, to the position of Town Historian salary of \$600.00 per annum retroactive to and effective January 1, 1967.

WHEREAS, pursuant to P.L. 89-117 the United States of America has authorized the making of grants to public bodies to aid in financing the construction of basic water and sewer project :

NOW ~~WHEREAS~~, BE it Resolved By the Town Board of the Town of Clarkstown

1. That Supervisor Paul F. Mundt be and he is hereby authorized to execute and file an application on behalf of the Town of Clarkstown with the Department of Housing and Urban Development, United States Government, for a grant to aid in financing the construction of Sewer Systems in Town Sewer District 18, 19, 20, 22, 23, 26, and 28, and an assurance of compliance with the Department of Housing and Urban

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Development regulations under Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

2. That Paul F. Mundt, Supervisor of the Town of Clarkstown be and he is hereby authorized and directed to furnish such information as the Department of Housing and Urban Development may reasonably request in connection with the application which is herein authorized to be filed.

RESOLVED, that the Supervisor be authorized to execute the necessary Civil Service form for the Provisional appointment, pending examination of EDWARD J. GHIZZA, of 23 Edward Street, Ossining, New York, to the position of DIRECTOR OF RECREATION for the Town of Clarkstown, at a salary of \$10,000 per annum effective April 3, 1967.

RESOLVED that the Supervisor be and he is hereby authorized to refund to the petitioner and charge Highway Account the amount of the erroneous tax, which is \$4.06

WHEREAS, Walter Brabowy has petitioned this Board for a refund of erroneous 1966 Zoning & Planning taxes on property in the Town of Clarkstown, assessed to Water Grabowy 31, Jerrys Avenue, Nanuet, N.Y. 10954 Map 161 Block A Lot 13.06 on account of this property was improperly taxed due to omission of Veteran's Exemption and was an erroneous assessment as cerified by the Clarkstown Assessor, therefore, be it

RESOLVED THAT THE Supervisor be and he is hereby authorized to refund to the petitioner and charge Zoning & Planning the amount of the erroneous tax, which is \$.73.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that said roads be included in the Town Highway System, and that the Town Attorney be directed to record the Deed.


Seconded by Councilman Frohling.
