RE: ALTERATION OF BOUNDARY LINE BETWEEN TALLMAN FIRE DISTRICT & MOLESTON FIRE DISTRICT

Supervisor McAlevey called joint public hearing to order.

Jerome M. Kornfeld appeared as attorney for petitioners (Fire District Commissioners of the Tallman Fire District, Town of Ramapo, and the Moleston Fire District, Towns of Ramapo, Clarkstown and Haverstraw).

Requests alteration of boundaries of Tallman Fire District and Moleston Fire District pursuant to provisions of Section 172-A of Town Law. Both Fire Districts situate in Town of Ramapo and are contiguous.

Alteration of boundaries will not include territory not previously situate within such Fire Districts nor will it exclude territory previously situate therein.

Petition signed by majority of members of the Board of Fire Commissioners of each Fire District. Would not affect assessed valuation of districts.

Tallman Fire District lies entirely in Ramapo. All area to the north part of which is Tallman and Moleston, become entirely Moleston. Effect: Assessor's office in Ramapo will have to make changes as far as taxes in each fire district is concerned.

Will not effect Moleston District as it effects Clarkstown and Haverstraw. Will not effect tax rate, except that it will give people in the north first call.


Re indebtedness: Bonded indebtedness on both sides. Will not change.

Councilman Matone (Haverstraw) Re consolidation: What is possibility?

Attorneys for petitioners: Would be legislative possibility - does not think it would ever happen. Does not effect assessed valuation of districts.

On resolution offered by Councilman Callaghan of Ramapo, seconded by Councilman Brooks of Haverstraw and unanimously adopted, public hearing was closed.
