Supervisors called Town Board meeting to order.

(806) Councilman Brenner offered the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the Town Board has met at the time and place specified in the Notice of Public Hearing on the Preliminary Budget and heard all persons desiring to be heard thereon; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that such preliminary budget be and hereby is adopted as the annual budget of the Town for the fiscal year beginning the 1st day of January, 1969, and that such budget as so adopted be entered in detail of the proceedings of this Town Board, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk of this Town shall prepare and certify in duplicate copies of such annual budget as adopted by this Town Board, together with the assessment rolls for benefit improvements, if any, adopted pursuant to Section 202-a, Subdivision 2, and Section 231, Subdivision 2, of the Town Law, and deliver one copy thereof to the Supervisor of this Town to be presented by him to the Board of Supervisors of this County.

Seconded by Councilman Damiani

All voted Aye.

(807) Councilman Frohling offered the following resolution:

WHEREAS, negotiations have been gone into with the Policemen's Benevolent Association of the Town of Clarkstown, now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Supervisor is hereby authorized to negotiate contract the said Policemen's Benevolent Association.

Seconded by Councilman Damiani.

(808) Councilman Brenner offered the following resolution:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 200 of the Town Law, the Town Board of the Town of Clarkstown is desirous of improving the street known as Pierce Street, situate of Nanuet, Town of Clarkstown, New York, and

WHEREAS, it is required that the property to be improved be surveyed, and such survey shall be filed in the Town Clerk's Office;

NOW THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, that Henry Horowitz be employed by the Town of Clarkstown to survey the property to be improved at a cost not to exceed \$800.00 to be reimbursed from the improvement district, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Engineer of the Town of Clarkstown prepared profiles showing the lines and grades to be established, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that said profile of the grades shall be filed in the Town Clerk's Office.

Seconded by Councilman Frohling.
