Supervisor Called Town Board meeting to order.

Residents of Virginia St., New City appeared re: closing of said street. Town Engineer stated that firm of Barbour, Jost & Boswell has been consulted re: study in connection with cutting crest of hill for better visibility. Deputy Town Attorney advised that public hearing would be necessary in order to close street. Engineers' report to be submitted at 8/6/69 Town Board meeting; Police Department to be contacted re speed and number of vehicles that use Virginia Street; said report also to be submitted at 8/6/69 Town Board meeting.

(605) Councilman Damiani offered the following resolution:

RESOLVED, that Virginia Street, New City, be made a one-way street, going from east to west, until permanent solution can be determined, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Highway Supt. is hereby authorized to install the necessary signs, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that Resolution No. 551 adopted at the Town Board meeting held on 7/16/69 is hereby rescinded.

(606) Councilman Damiani offered the following resolution:

RESOLVED, that the firm of Atzl, Scatassa & Caruso be authorized to submit study of drainage problem existing in the vicinity of Davies Lake (Millich property) New City, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the cost of said study is not to exceed amount of \$2500.00; said funds to be taken from Drainage Project No. 4.
