1970-724 Councilman D'Antoni offered the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the Town Board has met at the time and place specified in the Notice of Public Hearing on the Preliminary Budget for the Year 1971 and heard all persons desiring to be heard thereon;

NOW THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, that such Preliminary Budget, with amendments, be and hereby is adopted as the Annual Budget of the Town of Clarkstown for the Fiscal Year beginning the 1st day of January 1, 1971, and that such budget, as so adopted, be entered in detail of the proceedings of this Town Board; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk of the town shall prepare and certify, in duplicate, copies of such Annual Budget as adopted by this Town Board, together with the Assessment Rolls for benefit improvements, if any, adopted pursuant to Sec. 202-a, Subdiv. 2, and Sec. 231, Subdiv. 2 of the Town Law, and deliver one copy thereof to the Supervisor of this town to be presented by him to the Board of Supervisors of this County. RESOLVED, that the Supervisor be and he hereby is authorized to file objections to the said petition and/or petitions on behalf of the Town Board within the statutory time limit and that the Supervisor be authorized to direct the Town Attorney's Office to prepare and file such objections, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Supervisor be and he hereby is authorized to petition the Supreme Court of the State of New York on behalf of the Town Board to declare the petition and/or petitions requesting a permissive referendum on the resolution of 9/9/70 invalid.


