WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Clarkstown, on 7/21/72, adopted a resolution (#672-1972) authorizing the Supervisor to execute the necessary application forms required by the State of New York and its Conservation Department for financial assistance under the Outdoor Recreation Development Bond Act (Chapters 558, 559, Laws of 1965) and the Land and Water Conservation Fund Act of 1965 (78 Stat. 897-1964) to acquire the grounds commonly known as Camp Norge as an unspoiled natural area, and

WHEREAS, additional federal and state funds are available to aid the Town of Clarkstown in the acquisition of Camp Norge, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Clarkstown desires to reduce the burden falling upon local taxpayers in connection with the acquisition of Camp Norge;

NOW THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, that the Supervisor of the Town of Clarkstown be and is hereby authorized to execute any and all applications for financial assistance available from any federal or state agencies in connection with obtaining the maximum funds possible to aid in the purchase of the area commonly known as Camp Norge.
