Supervisor Vines called Special Town Board meeting to order.

1972-976 Councilman Niehaus offered the following resolution:

WHEREAS, Clarkstown Salvage Corp. has failed to live up to the terms and conditions of its agreement with the Town of Clarkstown dated 15<sup>th</sup> day of November 1971 and,

WHEREAS, Clarkstown Salvage Corp. has failed, neglected and refused to maintain the area occupied by it in the Clarkstown Sanitary Land Fill in a tidy, neat, clean and proper condition as required by said agreement and,

WHEREAS, the said Clarkstown Salvage Corp. is maintaining a supply of wrecked and abandoned vehicles and appliances in excess of a ten (10) day crushing capacity and,

WHEREAS, Clarkstown Salvage Corp. by its conduct is contributing to environmental pollution,

NOW THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, that it is in the best interest that the Sanitary Land Fill area be maintained in a tidy, clean and healthy condition and,


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Attorney's Office be and the same hereby directed to take all steps necessary to remove the Clarkstown Salvage Corp. from the Sanitary Land Fill area.
