Town Board members signed Consent to Special Meeting of the Town Board, waiving notice of said meeting.

(1975-674) Co. D'Antoni offered the following resolution:

WHEREAS, a dangerous condition exists on the streets, highways, public places and private properties in the Town of Clarkstown because of flooding resulting from excessive rains, and

WHEREAS, such flooding constitutes a danger to the lives and property of the citizens of the Town of Clarkstown and to the public health, safety and welfare;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, that the Supervisor of the Town of Clarkstown is hereby authorized pursuant to Section 209-m of the General Municipal Law to proclaim a state of emergency and to take all steps necessary, using agencies of the Town of Clarkstown and performing work on public and private lands, to protect the lives and property of the citizens of the Town of Clarkstown and that this authorization should be a continuing authorization to the Supervisor of the Town of Clarkstown until such time as said emergency is at an end.

Seconded by Co. Maloney

All voted Aye.

Supervisor Gerber issued the following PROCLAMATION:

**PROCLAMATION DECLARING STATE OF EMERGENCY
DUE TO FLOODING CRISIS**

WHEREAS, a dangerous condition exists on the streets, highways, public places and private properties in the Town of Clarkstown because of flooding resulting from excessive rains; and

WHEREAS, such flooding constitutes a danger to the lives and property of the citizens of the Town of Clarkstown and to the public health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisor of the Town of Clarkstown has certain powers granted to him by the Legislature of the State of New York under Section 209-m of the General Municipal Law to deal with such an emergency situation,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it PROCLAIMED as follows:

1. That a state of emergency continues to exist within the Town limits of the Town of Clarkstown outside of incorporated villages.

2. That the Highway Department, Police Department, and all other agencies of the Town of Clarkstown are hereby authorized to take all steps necessary to protect the lives and property from results of said flooding including entrance upon private property and the performance of emergency repairs and maintenance thereon.

3. This proclamation shall take effect immediately.

Dated: September 27th, 1975

Subsequent Proclamations continuing state of emergency issued by Supervisor Gerber on September 29th, 1975, October 2nd and October 5th, 1975.
