Supervisor Gerber called Special Town Board Meeting to order; Town Board members signed Consent to Special Meeting of the Town Board, waiving notice of said meeting.

(1975-841) Co. Lodico offered the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the Town of Clarkstown has commenced a proceeding for condemnation entitled as follows:

Town of Clarkstown,

Plaintiff

against

Lutheran Medical Center et al,

Respondents

and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of condemnation to the Town of Clarkstown is in excess of the amount originally contemplated, and

WHEREAS, the increased estimated cost of condemnation may have to be borne by the taxpayers of the Town of Clarkstown, and

WHEREAS, the condemnation of said property is therefore no longer considered to be in the best interests of the taxpayers of the Town of Clarkstown,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, that special counsel for the Town of Clarkstown be authorized to make application to the Supreme Court of the County of Rockland for the abandonment and discontinuance of said proceeding.

Seconded by Co. Maloney

All voted Aye.

There being no further business before the Town Board, on motion offered by Councilman Maloney, seconded by Councilman D'Antoni and unanimously adopted, Special Town Board Meeting was adjourned.
