

SPECIAL TOWN BOARD MEETING

Supervisor Gerber called Special Town Board Meeting to order; members of the Town Board signed Consent to Special Meeting, waiving notice of said meeting.

(1976-496) Co. Piacentile offered the following resolution:

WHEREAS, Councilman Piacentile, a member of the Town Board of the Town of Clarkstown, has introduced a proposed local law entitled "A LOCAL LAW OF THE TOWN OF CLARKSTOWN PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 24 OF THE STATE ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE PROTECTION, PRESERVATION AND CONSERVATION OF THE FRESHWATER WETLANDS WITHIN ITS BOUNDARIES BY ESTABLISHING A PERMIT SYSTEM WITH REGARD TO REGULATED ACTIVITIES IN FRESHWATER WETLANDS AND ADJACENT AREAS AND BY ESTABLISHING THE PROCEDURES AND STANDARDS FOR THE PROCESSING OF PERMIT APPLICATIONS" and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Clarkstown considers that it is in the best public interest that said local law be adopted;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, that a public hearing, pursuant to Section 20 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, be had at the Auditorium in the Town Hall, 10 Maple Avenue, New City, New York, on the 25th day of August, 1976, at 8:13 PM, relative to such proposed local law, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that notice of the time, place and purpose of such hearing shall be published in the Journal News, the official newspaper of the Town of Clarkstown, and posted in the manner provided by law, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Attorney prepare notice of said hearing and that the Town Clerk cause the same to be published and posted as aforesaid and file proof thereof in the office of the said Clerk.

Seconded by Co. Maloney All voted Aye.

(1976-497) Co. Maloney offered the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Clarkstown desires to acquire certain easements and lands for drainage purposes;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, that the Town Attorney be and he hereby is authorized to commence proceedings to acquire said lands for drainage purposes, in accordance with the metes and bounds descriptions being prepared by Jack D. Boswell & Associates, by negotiation, agreement and/or condemnation as the Town Attorney may find appropriate, and be it

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FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Supervisor of the Town of Clarkstown is hereby authorized to employ two (2) appraisers in order to obtain the necessary financial data for good faith negotiations as required by the Condemnation Law of the State of New York, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Attorney be and he hereby is directed to proceed forthwith to obtain orders permitting immediate possession of the said property pending the final outcome of condemnation proceedings and/or negotiations hereinabove authorized.
