Supervisor Gerber called the meeting to order and affirmed that all members of the Board were informed of the meeting.

(1976-600) Co. D'Antoni offered the following resolution;

RESOLVED: that based upon the recommendation of the Director of Purchasing, the bid for the printing of the 1976-1977 FALL and WINTER BROCHURE of the CLARKSTOWN PARKS BOARD AND RECREATION COMMISSION is hereby awarded to W.J.R. PRINTERS, INC., 19 Gramercy Place, Thornwood, New York at the low bid price of \$2,485.00, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that funds for the same be taken from Account #7310, Line 405.

(1976-601) Co. Piacentile offered the following resolution,

RESOLVED, that the Supervisor of the Town of Clarkstown is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Borough of Ringwood for the use of the Clarkstown Sanitary Landfill Area by the Borough of Ringwood at the rate of 60¢ per cubic yard, for successive thirty day periods with the right of cancellation by the Town of Clarkstown.

(1976-602) Co. D'Antoni offered the following resolution,

WHEREAS, Councilman D'Antoni, a member of the Town Board of the Town of Clarkstown has introduced a proposed local law entitled "A LOCAL LAW FOR THE CONDUCT OF GAMES OF CHANCE BY CERTAIN ORGANIZATIONS IN THE TOWN OF CLARKSTOWN", and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Clarkstown considers that it is in the best public interest that said local law be adopted;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, that a public hearing pursuant to Section 20 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, be had at the auditorium of the Town Hall, 10 Maple Avenue, New City, New York, on the 15th day of September, 1976, at 9:00 P.M., relative to such proposed local law, and be it further

RESOLVED, that notice of the time, place and purpose of such hearing shall be published in the Journal News, the official newspaper of the Town, and posted in the manner provided by law, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Attorney prepare notice of such hearing and that the Town Clerk cause the same to be published and posted as aforesaid and file proof thereof in the office of the said Clerk.
