

SPECIAL TOWN BOARD MEETING

Town Hall

Present: Co. D'Antoni, Holbrook, Maloney, Piacentile, Supervisor Gerber, Murray N. Jacobson, Town Attorney, John R. Bradley, Town Clerk.

Supervisor Gerber called the meeting to order, assemblage saluted the flag.

1977-390 Co. Maloney offered the following resolution:

RESOLVED, that the Town Board Resolution No. 305 adopted on May 4, 1977, be amended by deleting therefrom the name of Murray N. Jacobson, Town Attorney, and substituting therefor the name of Philip B. Fogel, 1st Deputy Town Attorney, as a member of the management negotiating committee with the various organizations representing the employees of the Town of Clarkstown on contracts terminating on December 31, 1977.

Seconded by Co. D'Antoni.

All voted Aye.

1977-391 Co. Maloney offered the following resolution:

WHEREAS, Town Law Section 20(1) has been amended by adding thereto Paragraph (g) which reads as follows:

"g. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general, special or local law to the contrary, the town board of the Town of Clarkstown, county of Rockland, may adopt a resolution at least one hundred fifty days prior to any biennial town election determining that such town shall have three town justices. If the town board of such town shall have adopted such a resolution, the electors of such town shall elect at the succeeding biennial election, and quadrennially thereafter, such additional town justice for a term of four years beginning on the first day of January next succeeding such biennial town election."

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, that pursuant to Town Law Section 20(1) (g), the office of the third town justice be and the same hereby is created within the Town of Clarkstown for a term of four (4) years commencing on the first day of January, 1978, and quadrennially thereafter, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the said position of third town justice be filled at the biennial Town election to be held on November 8, 1977.

Seconded by Co. D'Antoni.

All voted Aye.

There being no further business to come before the Special Town Board meeting, Supervisor Gerber declared the meeting adjourned at 7:12 P.M.
