Supervisor Dusanenko declared the Special Town Board Meeting open; assemblage saluted the Flag. Members signed consent for Special Town Board Meeting.

Councilman Maloney read a Proposed Resolution regarding the Sewer Sludge Composting Facility.

Supervisor Dusanenko suggested that the following clause be deleted from the resolution: FURTHER RESOLVED, that in the event the Supervisor of the Town of Clarkstown fails to introduce such resolution, then one or more of the Town Board members are hereby authorized and instructed to appear on behalf of the Town Board before the Commissioners and present to the members a copy of this resolution of the Town Board and that it be changed to read the Supervisor be joined by the four councilmen at the next Sewer Commission Meeting. Supervisor Dusanenko said he had no problem in passing the resolution but he would like the elimination of the second WHEREAS clause and the second FURTHER RESOLVED clause. (Proposed resolution on file in the Town Clerk's Office.)

Councilman Lettre suggested that copies of the resolution be sent to the members of the Sewer Commission.

Supervisor Dusanenko in an exchange of views with Councilman Maloney said he missed few if any sewer meetings and had a good record.

Councilman Carey was concerned about events in the past and would like to see the resolution remain as is.

Councilman Holbrook asked if the Sewer Commission meeting could be moved to Town Hall.

Supervisor said that this be put in the resolution as a Resolved clause. The agreed upon date was September 19th and the time be changed from 5:30 to 7:00 P.M.

OPPOSING PRESENT PROPOSAL TO
CONSTRUCT AND OPERATE A SEWER
SLUDGE COMPOSTING FACILITY ON
LAND ADJACENT TO THE CLARKSTOWN
SANITARY LANDFILL

Co. Holbrook offered the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the Supervisor of the Town of Clarkstown, who serves as a member of the Board of Commissioners of the Rockland County Sewer District No. 1, voted in favor of a resolution to locate a sludge treatment plant in West Nyack in the vicinity of the Clarkstown Landfill without informing or consulting with members of the Town Board, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board believes the method proposed to handle the sewer sludge may be detrimental to the health and welfare of the residents of the Town of Clarkstown and Rockland County, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board recognizes the need for expansion of the existing sewer department facilities in order to plan for the orderly growth of the Towns of Clarkstown and Ramapo;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Clarkstown is opposed to the present proposal to construct and operate a sewer sludge composting facility on land adjacent to the Clarkstown Sanitary Landfill, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Supervisor of the Town of Clarkstown is hereby authorized and requested to introduce a resolution at the next meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Rockland County Sewer District to implement this resolved of the Town Board, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Board authorizes and directs the Town Clerk of the Town of Clarkstown to send certified copies of this resolution to all Clarkstown Rockland County Legislators, New York State Department of Environmental Conservation and elected State officials, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Board requests the relocation of the Rockland County Sewer District meeting of September 19, 1983, from the Town of Orangetown to the Town of Clarkstown, Town Hall, 10 Maple Avenue, New City, New York, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Board requests the time of the meeting be changed from 5:30 P.M. to 7:00 P.M.
