Supervisor Charles E. Holbrook opened the Organizational Meeting. Supervisor called upon Rev. Robert Morisseau of St. John's Episcopal Church in New City to give the invocation which he did.

Councilman Steven C. Kunis was then sworn in by Justice Harry Waitzman. Councilman Kunis stated that he was ready to serve all the people of the Town of Clarkstown and would take his duties very seriously. He wished all the new appointees the best of luck, health and success in their new positions. He wished Supervisor Holbrook, Councilwoman Smith and Town Clerk Sheridan the best of luck and success as they start their new terms. He said he was looking forward to working with the Clarkstown government team in a positive, constructive manner so that in the next four years he would dedicate himself to making Clarkstown a better place to live. He stated that if he could be of any help to any resident he urged them to contact him as he would listen and treat them with the utmost respect.

Councilwoman Anne Marie Smith was sworn in by Justice Harry Waitzman. Councilwoman Smith said she was happy and proud to take her second oath of office in as many years. She said two major problems face this municipality at this moment and Clarkstown has taken the lead in finding solutions. She said they will extend the life of the landfill with the recycling program. She mentioned the garbage problem and also the fact that there will be monthly instead of annual bulk pickup. She touched upon many topics among them the possibility of the landfill closing and what could be done in that case; a municipal sanitation district for which she mentioned the efforts of Supervisor Holbrook; health insurance costs; organization of town departments and boards; updating of the Town code; housing for youth and seniors; day care; and the Clarkstown Police Department. She said she was proud to be a part of the Clarkstown Town Board and with the other members would continue to serve all of the people of Clarkstown into the future.

Town Clerk Patricia Sheridan was sworn in by Judge John Reilly who asked her family to take their place beside her as she was sworn in. Judge Reilly gave a lovely introduction to the Town Clerk and spoke very highly of her and her dedication to her position as Clarkstown Town Clerk. Mrs. Sheridan warmly thanked Judge Reilly and the people of Clarkstown.

Superintendent of Highways Anthony D'Antoni was sworn in by Justice William Wray. Mr. D'Antoni stated that he was happy to be back in Clarkstown government and it was a pleasure to work for the people of Clarkstown. Supervisor said that Mr. D'Antoni has served as Councilman, Deputy Supervisor, Receiver of Taxes and now Superintendent of Highways.

Justice Kenneth Ronces was sworn in by Justice William Wray. Justice Ronces thanked everyone.

Supervisor Charles Holbrook was sworn in by Justice Harry Waitzman. Supervisor Holbrook then read the following State of the Town address:

*January 4, 1988

Dear Citizens of Clarkstown and Town Board Members:

It has indeed been a pleasure to have served the past two years as Supervisor of Clarkstown. I look forward to my next two years with great expectations and with great enthusiasm.

This Town Board will be an historic Board because it will provide the leadership that is essential in order to solve the solid waste situation.

All of us know and recognize the futility that the County has experienced in dealing with this problem throughout the 1980s. It is up to the Towns to provide the leadership to bring this problem to a satisfactory conclusion. I am proud to say that, with the support of the Town Board, Clarkstown has used its landfill to provide the leadership that has been lacking for so long. During 1988, Clarkstown, Orangetown and Ramapo (the latter two Towns which depend upon the Clarkstown Landfill) will begin comprehensive recycling programs. This will be a new experience for our residents but it is one which I am sure they will understand and to which they can lend their support. However, recycling is but the first step toward obtaining control of the solid waste crisis.

All of us know that the State Department of Environmental Control permits our landfill to operate only with a Consent Order. The Clarkstown Landfill can be closed on 270 days' notice. This situation has existed since the early 1980s. I can assure you that, unless an ultimate solution to solid waste is found, the State Department of Environmental Conservation will rapidly move to close the Clarkstown Landfill. In order to avoid such an occurrence, on Wednesday evening, January 6th, there will be a meeting involving the Town Boards of Clarkstown, Orangetown and Ramapo. Hopefully, this meeting will provide the good will, trust and understanding that will be essential toward laying the foundation for the solution to the solid waste crisis.

The solid waste problem is pervasive throughout the United States. Every American, if he is not affected by it now, will soon be affected. The cost of disposing of solid waste is so burdensome that it is beyond the capacity of a single town to deal with it on its own. This is why our Towns must unite in order to share this costly burden. No one can declare "free agency" in the solid waste crisis. No one can say "it is not my problem." We know that it is everyone's problem.

I am proud to say that the members of the Town Board feel as I do that this is the No. 1 issue that faces Clarkstown and Rockland County. This is not to say that other issues are unimportant, but the disposal of garbage is a daily occurrence and the specter of "The Barge" looms ever present.

Hence, I look forward to enacting our recycling program, in conjunction with Orangetown and Ramapo. It will prove to be environmentally sound and will help provide the basis for whatever solution to solid waste is eventually determined upon. At present there are only two ways to dispose of garbage. You can either burn it or bury it. The Town Boards of Clarkstown, Orangetown and Ramapo intend to pursue both of these alternatives. There are many environmental studies that must be done prior to the final site selection of a landfill or a resource recovery plant. This is the year a decision must be made. We can wait no longer.

Finally, if there is one thing that elected officials can do for their constituents, it is to provide for their future needs. In regard to the garbage crisis, the future is now. I know this Town Board has the intestinal fortitude to make the right decisions. I look forward to working with them on this and the other important issues which face the Town.

- (l) Refrigerated trucks;
- (m) Tractors;
- (n) Combines;
- (o) School buses used as such;
- (p) Qualified moving vans;
- (q) Qualified specialized utility repair trucks;
- (r) Officially authorized use of unmarked vehicles by law enforcement officers.
