AMENDING RESOLUTION NO.  
584-1988 GRANTING EXTENSION  
OF TIME FOR COMMENTS AND  
RECOMMENDATIONS WITH  
RESPECT TO CLINTON SQUARE  
PLAZA, INC. TO SEPTEMBER 1,  
1988

Co. Maloney offered the following resolution:

RESOLVED, that Resolution No. 584-1988 adopted by the Town Board on June 2, 1988, regarding granting an extension of time for comments and recommendations with respect to Clinton Square Plaza, Inc., to September 1, 1988, is hereby amended to read as follows:

WHEREAS, the Rockland County Commissioner of Planning and the New York State Department of Transportation have requested an extension of time from June 10, 1988 to September 1, 1988, to submit recommendations to the Town Board with respect to their review of the Draft Generic Environmental Impact Statement (DGEIS) concerning Clinton Square Plaza, Inc. petition for a change of zone from an LIO District to an MRS District, on property designated on the Clarkstown Tax Map as Map 89, Block A, Lots 4, 12.02 and 13; Map 106, Block A, Lots 25, 45, 45.0101, 46, 47.01, 48 and 49;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, that the Town Board hereby grants an extension of time from June 10, 1988 to September 1, 1988, to submit recommendations and comments to the Town Board with respect to their review of the DGEIS concerning Clinton Square Plaza, Inc., petition for a change of zone from an LIO District to an MRS District, on property designated on the Clarkstown Tax Map as Map 89, Block A, Lots 4, 12.02 and 13; Map 106, Block A, Lots 25, 45, 45.0101, 46, 47.01, 48 and 49.

Seconded by Co. Kunis

Councilman Carey said he was voting yes but he believed that the resolution should include "and any other interested agencies and parties."

Councilman Kunis said he was voting yes but he would be willing to take all information from any other individuals or parties.

Councilman Maloney said yes he too would be willing to read and discuss any additional information.

Councilwoman Smith said yes for the two agencies and she would welcome any other additional information.

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Supervisor Holbrook said he was voting yes and would echo Councilman Carey's comments.

There being no further business to come before the Town Board and no one wishing to be heard, on motion of Councilman Maloney, seconded by Councilman Kunis and unanimously adopted, the Special Town Board Meeting was declared closed, time: 9:54 A.M.
