RE: PROPOSED LOCAL LAW - HOMESTEAD AND NON-HOMESTEAD PROPORTION

By NOTICE OF SPECIAL MEETING OF TOWN BOARD signed by Supervisor Holbrook on July 7, 1989, a Special Meeting of the Town Board was called to be held for the purpose of introducing a local law. The meeting was opened at 10:10 P.M.

RESOLUTION SETTING PUBLIC HEARING ON A PROPOSED LOCAL LAW RE REAL PROPERTY TAX LAW, SECTION 1903

Councilman Carey offered the following resolution:

WHEREAS, Councilman Carey, a member of the Town Board of the Town of Clarkstown has introduced a proposed local law entitled,

"A LOCAL LAW TO ADOPT THE PROVISIONS OF REAL PROPERTY TAX LAW, SECTION 1903, CONCERNING HOMESTEAD BASE PROPORTION AND NON-HOMESTEAD BASE PROPORTION, IN THE MANNER PROVIDED BY CHAPTER 223 OF THE LAWS OF 1989."

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, that a public hearing pursuant to Section 20 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, be had at the Auditorium of the Town Hall, 10 Maple Avenue, New City, New York, on the 18th day of July 1989, at 8:15 P.M., or as soon thereafter as possible, relative to such proposed local law, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that notice of the time, place and purpose of such hearing shall be published in the Journal News, the official newspaper of the Town of Clarkstown and posted in the manner provided by law, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Attorney prepare notice of said hearing and that the Town Clerk cause the same to be published and posted as aforesaid and file proof thereof in the office of the said Clerk.

The NOTICE OF SPECIAL MEETING OF TOWN BOARD of the Town of Clarkstown shall be filed in the Town Clerk's Office.


