RESOLUTION REQUESTING
CONSIDERATION FROM COUNTY
LEGISLATURE FOR RESIDENTIAL
PROPERTIES ON NORTH SIDE OF
PROPOSED WIDENING OF
CONGERS ROAD

Co. Maloney offered and Co. Duanenko seconded

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Clarkstown wishes to express its thoughts and desires concerning the proposed realignment of Kings Highway and Old Haverstraw Road, at the intersection of Lake Road, and the widening of Congers Road from the causeway to Kings Highway, Congers, New York;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, as follows:

1. The construction area of the proposed road widening should be moved as far south as possible, and also be constructed in the manner proposed by the original plan of the Rockland County Highway Department;
2. There should be minimal impact on the residential properties situated on the north side of the road which would be affected by any cut and fill operation;
3. Provisions should be made to keep traffic open on one side of the road while the other side is being constructed;
4. No condemnation of residential properties be made, nor easements taken on residential properties situated on the north side of the road.
