GENERAL VEHICLE POLICY

- A. The Town of Clarkstown owns and maintains vehicles that are to be driven only by Town employees, holding appropriate driver licenses, to carry out the official business of the Town. Vehicles are assigned to specific departments and are to be used exclusively for official business.
- B. Department heads are responsible for assuring that the vehicles assigned to their specific departments are used only in compliance with this "General Vehicle Policy," and any other applicable regulations or resolutions of the Town Board. Department heads are also responsible for maintaining "Mandatory Vehicle Records" for the vehicles assigned to their departments. Such records shall be available for inspection at all times.
- C. The Town Board reserves the sole right to assign vehicles on a twenty-four (24) hour basis to employees holding specific job titles, and, then, only when it determines that the use of such vehicles on such basis is required in order to respond to urgent situations requiring immediate attention.
- D. No vehicles may be used by Town employees for personal reasons, except that those employees assigned vehicles on a 24-hour basis may use them for commuting to and from work.
- E. Each vehicle not specifically assigned on a twenty-four hour basis shall be parked during non-work hours in the parking lot of the Town facility to which it is most frequently assigned.

(B) A "Vehicle Use Log" shall also be maintained reflecting daily use and shall contain entries as to the following:

3. Plate number
4. Odometer reading at beginning and end of daily use*
5. Each operator of the vehicle during that day*

*No such entry need be made if the vehicle is not used on a particular work day.

(C) The Insurance and Claims Manager shall maintain a "Master Vehicle Log" of all Town Vehicles indicating the following:

1. Vehicle description (Make/model/color)
2. Vehicle identification number
3. Vehicle plate number
4. Department to which vehicle is assigned
5. Odometer reading upon transfer of vehicle between departments,
