The Clarkstown Police Honor Guard presented the colors. Co. Maloney led the assemblage in the Pledge of Allegiance. Police Chaplain, Rev. David Lothrop, gave the invocation and introduced Supervisor Alexander J. Gromack. R. C. Judge William Nelson administered the oath of office for the Supervisor.

The Supervisor delivered the following State of the Town address:

Let me first start by extending my wishes for a healthy and happy New Years to all of you, your families and friends.

Honorable guests, members of the Town Board and friends...

The annual reorganization meeting provides me with an opportunity to talk about what happened in Town Government last year and what we plan to accomplish this year.

Having served as a County Legislator for 7 years and as a State Assemblyman for 14, I've learned that when elected officials don't work together then government doesn't work.

When our elected officials don't put people before politics then nothing gets done...problems get worse...residents begin to lose faith in their government and all of us suffer.

Since I became Supervisor in August, I have received both the strong support and valued counsel of our Town Board.

We have worked together in a frank, open and honest way, putting politics aside and putting our residents first. I could not have had better partners.

I thank them for that support and pledge to continue that spirit of collaboration and cooperation between my office and the Town Board.

I also want to thank our Town Department Heads for their encouragement and assistance during these first few months of my administration and to express my appreciation to the chairs and members of the Town's Commissions who have provided me with an excellent overview of the issues and challenges facing Clarkstown.

And of course I want to express a special thanks to our Town employees.

I've made it a point to visit them where they work, to talk to them about their jobs and their concerns.

It is clear to me that they take a great deal of deserved pride in what they do. They care about our Town and the people who make Clarkstown home...and I thank them for that and ask them for continued efforts.

When we talk about what Town Government has done we tend to use numbers and facts.

We point to statistics, awards or buildings as proof of what has been accomplished.

Recently, Clarkstown was again chosen as the 5th safest town of its size in the nation.

That's quite an accomplishment...it's a verifiable fact and it's a tribute to the men and women who lead and serve in our Police Department.

The Citywatch Telephone Notification System that has already been used by our Police can notify our residents within minutes of an emergency situation that may require action on their part to protect their homes and their families.

Our town's Emergency Operation Center established in 1996, is equipped with some of the latest technology and can be 'up and running' with 15 minutes notice.

The safety of our residents has always been a priority of our elected officials and it will continue to be 'job 1' of this administration and the Town Board.

Our Highway Department under the able and valued leadership of Superintendent Wayne Ballard can verify that 72% of our roads are now rated as excellent due to his aggressive maintenance and resurfacing program and that more leaves were picked up this year without the use of any outside contractors.

In addition the Department installed 12,000 feet of new drainage pipe and 70 new catch basins and through its partnership with outside agencies participated in a number of successful community projects that beautified our town and saved tax dollars.

Our Zoning Board of Appeals under Chairman Arnold Amster and our Planning Board under Shirley Thormann have worked hard to eliminate any unnecessary delays and red tape that applicants may face while working just as hard to protect our community's character and charm.

Our Data Processing Department continues to upgrade our Town's ability to store, share, retrieve, analyze and use data to make government more responsive, more efficient and more economical.

Our Town's web site has been revamped...and it provides a wealth of information on services, departments, commissions and events.

Residents can find out about our Mini Trans system that transported over 150,000 passengers across our Town, from Spring Valley to New City...or about property tax exemptions or about Santa's visiting schedule.

We are very proud of the Congers revitalization project lead by our DEC and the continuing successful efforts to expand our Recreation and Parks with the opening of the Miniature Golf Course at Germonds.

Our "Open Space" initiative which was begun in 2001 continues to identify land that should be purchased by the Town to eliminate run away development and to preserve the nature and quality of our community.

There are many more accomplishments that we can point to and many more people and departments we can commend.

But there is another point I want to make.

As important as these accomplishments are we can sometimes miss the real message.

What is being demonstrated here is a commitment to our Town, from those who live here, to those who work here, to those who have been elected to keep Clarkstown a place where we want to live...a place we are proud to call home.

This dedication and hard work is fueled by the hopes and dreams that each of us have for our town.

Tonight for the next few minutes, I want to share my hopes and dreams for Clarkstown.

I see us as something more than just a geographical entity on a map...something more than just a collection of hamlets grouped together in the same general location.

I see us a community...A group of people who are tied together because of their common desire to live in a place where they and their families can flourish.

A community where we all understand that what happens to one of us happens to us all.

That means our government needs to reflect that community, to reflect its hopes and dreams, to identify and tackle its problems and concerns and most of all to put the people of that community first.

I believe that is what Government is all about and that more importantly, I believe that is what our Town Government should be all about.

This year, my efforts and energies will be directed toward a number of goals:

First, and we have already begun this process...we must focus on our drainage problems.

While it is true that 98% of our residents have no worry about floods in their basements...the fact is no one should have to worry about flooded basements.

My Drainage Task Force is bringing together Town resources to identify problems...establish priorities...locate the roadblocks and then work in a collaborative but forceful and timely way within the town and with county...state...and federal agencies to get those problems fixed.

Secondly, my office, the Town Attorney...Planning Department...the DEC and our Recreation and Parks Department will work on refining, fine tuning and expanding our land acquisitions under the "Open Space" Initiative.

I want to make sure that when we use public money to purchase land we are fulfilling the philosophy and purpose behind this initiative...to preserve and provide more open space throughout our town for every hamlet and every village and every resident.

In order to accomplish that I will initiate meetings with community leaders from across our Town to ensure that our plans for the land we purchase are inclusive and representative of all our communities.

STATE OF THE TOWN ADDRESS CONT.

In addition to continuing the "Open Space" Initiative we will also continue our revitalization program with projects in Valley Cottage...New City and Nanuet on the drawing board.

...and I will draw upon my 14 years in the State Assembly and 7 years in the County Legislature to bring additional financial and technical assistance to our villages and hamlets that make up Clarkstown.

I want to ensure that every Clarkstown tax dollar is used wisely...efficiently and fairly to provide services to all our neighborhoods and communities.

The hallmark of Town Government...must be constituent service...providing for the needs and concerns of every resident.

That means increased accountability and challenging our competent and dedicated employees to be even more creative, more demanding of themselves and more committed to the people who pay those taxes.

For years...there have been complaints voiced about Cable TV services...prices increasing...programming choices decreasing...seniors being left out in the cold. The problem was there was only one game in town.

We listened and asked a simple question. Why not invite another team to the game.

Why not give the people of Clarkstown a second choice. The result...today both Cablevision and Verizon are negotiating with us for cable TV franchise agreements.

Finally...I want our Town Government to listen...not to just what we want to hear...but to what we must hear if we are to govern fairly and effectively.

We can't build a community on what one person or one group has to say. A community requires input and participation from everyone. We are all stakeholders in our Town.

There is no place for indifference.

But if we do not continue in our efforts to work together...then our indifference toward the concerns of others will separate and divide us..and no community can exist when it is divided.

We have a New Year in front of us...and a tradition of success...hard work and commitment behind us.

Let us remember to bring the history of our past successes into this New Year...but let us also bring a renewed sense of cooperation and collaboration.

I look forward to working with the members of our Town Board...my fellow elected officials across our Town...County...State and Federal Governments.

I look forward to working with County Executive Scott Vanderhoeff.

We are currently discussing a number of projects that will demonstrate a new sense of partnership and collaboration between County & Town.

But most importantly...I look forward to working with each and every resident of Clarkstown to forge an even stronger sense of community...and making our Town an even better place to live and work... an even better place to call home.

Thank you...and God Bless you.

WHEREAS, Regulations of the Internal Revenue Service have been promulgated which require employers, including municipal employers, to include for personal income tax purposes, the value of employer owned vehicles used for private purposes or for commuting to and from work;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED, that the Town Comptroller is hereby authorized and directed for the period commencing January 1, 2005 and ending December 31, 2005, to credit as additional income the sum of \$3.00 per work day or 40.5¢ per mile, or the current applicable rate in effect for the year as per the Internal Revenue Service, whichever is less to those employees who have the use of Town owned vehicles for commuting to and from work except those employees who are public officers as defined in Section 263.14 of the Handbook for State Social Security Administration, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that employees, other than elected officials, who have the use of Town owned vehicles shall not use any vehicle assigned to such employee for personal reasons except for commuting to and from work, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the employer provided vehicles as set forth below shall be excluded from the wage calculation:

- (b) Delivery trucks with seating only for the driver, or only for the driver plus a folding jump seat;

- (e) Passenger buses used as such with a capacity of at least twenty (20) passengers;
- (f) Ambulances used as such or hearses used as such;
- (g) Bucket trucks (cherry pickers);
- (h) Cranes and derricks;
- (i) Forklifts;
- (j) Cement Mixers;
- (k) Dump trucks (including garbage trucks);
- (l) Refrigerated trucks;
- (m) Tractors;
- (n) Combines;
- (o) School buses used as such;
- (p) Qualified moving vans;
- (q) Qualified specialized utility repair trucks;
- (r) Officially authorized use of unmarked vehicles by law enforcement officers.
