RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUPERVISOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE CLARKSTOWN CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR THE SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER PROGRAM FOR THE 2012-2013 SCHOOL TERM

WHEREAS, a School Resource Officer Program has been proposed for the Clarkstown Central School District, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Clarkstown Central School District and the Clarkstown Police Department desire to provide law enforcement services of three (3) police officers to be assigned to the school district on a full time basis as the School Resource Officers;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, that the Town Board hereby authorizes the Supervisor to enter into an agreement with the Board of Education of the Clarkstown Central School District, in a form satisfactory to the Town Attorney, to authorize the Clarkstown Police Department to provide law enforcement services consisting of three (3) police officers to the Clarkstown Central School District on a full time basis, for the period September 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the agreement shall provide, along with other provisions required by the Town Attorney, for contractual indemnification of the Town, professional and other liability insurance coverage, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution is subject to the financial contribution of the Clarkstown Central School District to the Town of Clarkstown in the amount of \$110,132.00 for the School Resource Officers.

PERFORMANCE AGREEMENT FOR INCOMPLETE ITEMS
CONCERNING ROCKLAND HOSPITALITY ASSOCIATES, LLC SITE PLAN
(A/K/A COMFORT INN)

WHEREAS, Rockland Hospitality Associates, LLC furnished to the Town of Clarkstown a Performance Agreement secured by an Assignment of Certificate of Deposit in the amount of \$81,000, to cover the improvements as shown on the approved site plan entitled Rockland Hospitality Associates, LLC, dated 11/19/03, and

WHEREAS, the First Deputy Director of the Department of Environmental Control of the Town of Clarkstown has recommended that said Performance Agreement be reduced to \$66,000, as a portion of the work has been completed to Town specifications;

**RESOLUTION TO POST 'NO PARKING ANYTIME' SIGNS AT THE DEAD
END OF LORAN COURT, NANUET**

WHEREAS, Loran Court, Nanuet, a dead end Cul de Sac off Blauvelt Road, had become a parking refuge for Nanuet High School students due to its proximity to the High School, and

WHEREAS, by Town Board Resolution #381-2008, this situation was resolved with the installation of "No Parking 8AM to 4PM, School Days" signs, and

WHEREAS, the Dead End of Loran Court has become a refuge at other times of the day and evening causing driveway blockages at #'s 17 & 18 Loran Court;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, that the Superintendent of Highways is hereby authorized to install "NO PARKING ANYTIME" signs with opposing arrows in two locations past the driveways of #'s 17 & 18 Loran Court to prohibit parking anytime in the terminus of the Cul-de-Sac, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief of Police is to be forwarded a copy of this resolution for information and enforcement.
