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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CONTINUATION OF A PUBLIC HEARING
ON THE DESIGNATION OF AN HISTORICAL SITE
TAX MAP 51.10-3-1

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Clarkstown, by resolution adopted on September 29, 2015, set a public hearing concerning the proposed designation of the Cropsey house and barn and the immediate property surrounding both located at 230 South Little Tor Road, New City, New York, designated on the Clarkstown Tax Map as Map 51.10-3-1, as an historical site pursuant to Chapter 25-3(C) of the Town Code of the Town of Clarkstown, and

WHEREAS, on October 20, 2015, a public hearing was held to consider said designation, and at such time it was determined by the Town Board that the hearing be continued on November 17, 2015 to allow the Town board more time to review an engineering report prepared regarding the Cropsey barn and to consider the County's input;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, that the public hearing will be continued on November 17, 2015, at 7:00 P.M., or as soon thereafter as possible, at the Auditorium of the Clarkstown Town Hall, 10 Maple Avenue, New City, New York, to consider the designation of the aforesaid house, barn and immediate surrounding property as an historical site, and be it
