WHEREAS, the Town of Clarkstown proposes to construct the Demarest Kill Flood Mitigation Project, a/k/a the Cranford Drive Drainage Project, and will award a contract to a contractor for the contemplated construction of certain improvements as shown and specified in the contract documents and said improvements will consist of stream improvements and embankment stabilization, and

WHEREAS, the County of Rockland and the Town of Clarkstown desire to enter into an agreement for the County to reimburse the Town for a portion of the actual construction and consulting engineer's construction support for these improvements to the Demarest Kill and the County has agreed to reimburse the Town for said costs relating to the Project, as shown and specified in the contract documents, at the rate of forty (40%) of such costs paid to the contractor and other parties not to exceed ONE MILLION (\$1,000,000.00) DOLLARS;
