BOND RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF CLARKSTOWN, NEW YORK, ADOPTED JUNE 6, 2017, AUTHORIZING REPLACEMENT OF CATCH BASIN STRUCTURE LOCATED AT JEFFREY PLACE, STATING THE ESTIMATED MAXIMUM COST THEREOF IS \$14,200, APPROPRIATING SAID AMOUNT FOR SUCH PURPOSE, AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS IN THE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF \$14,200 TO FINANCE SAID APPROPRIATION

The object or purpose for which the bonds are authorized is replacement of the catch basin structure located at Jeffrey Place in the Town.

The amount of obligations authorized to be issued is \$14,200.

The period of probable usefulness is fifteen (15) years, however it is hereby determined that the maximum term of such bonds will not exceed five (5) years.
