First and foremost, thank you to the Town Board for putting together a process that allows the public to have input on the drawing of the ward lines.

At the Town Board workshop on January 10th, the consultant from Skyline Consulting talked about different options when it comes to current elected officials. I think it is important that the ward lines be "incumbent blind". The main focus of the wards should equal population and equal voting age population while maintaining existing election districts where possible. This will reduce the potential risk of gerrymandering that occurred when the Legislative Districts were created. It will also limit the percent deviation between the smallest and largest wards.

I look forward to being a part of the process and appreciate you setting up two public hearings; one before the drawing of the ward lines and one after the drawing of the ward lines.
